Some contractors will try their best to circumvent or sidestep site safety requirements such as medicals and induction and may see this as saving time by getting onto site easier and quicker. This course will explain the legal implication by doing this should you be caught or worse, be involved in an accident.

In this training session we will explain why site safety protocols are required to ensure that the legal obligations of all parties including the LMI are met. We will also clarify the difference between what is legally required and what may be a site-specific requirement.

This is not a Safety Officer's course but will give an LMI who is required to go to site a good awareness of site safety.

3. Other OHSA or MHSA requirements
4. Legal appointments
